REPORT FROM MIKE McELROY

Mike reported that the Army Corps, Rock Island Division, had a team meeting on June 7, 2010 to discuss the dredge material. They discussed the study criteria from Foth Engineering. Mike asked the Army Corps for a copy of the Foth study. They said it would be at least another week before this was available. Steve feels that the people on the team are starting to see some of the things we see.

Mike stated that he wishes State Representative Kevin Joyce well.

Mike reported that the Senate Resoulution 0755 sponsored by Senator Maloney is still in the Environmental Committee.

Mike spoke with Brian from Rep. Lipinski's office. They are trying to put together verbage to help us with Lucas Berg. Mike gave him information on what our fight is all about.

Mike stated that he tried to reach out to Terrance O'Brien and Richard Lanyon from the MWRD to talk about the location at 138th street, which was dredged in the 1970's. Mike took pictures of how this looks now, showing that it is not good, poor water control, not kept up. Mike sent pictures to O'Brien who forwarded them to Lanyon. Lanyon said that there was no dredging in the 1970's. Mike proposes to educate the MWRD on the history of the dredging at 138th Street and possible dredging at Lucas Berg Nature Preserve because the MWRD is suppose to protect our environment .
