Yard Waste & Chipper Service Last day for yard waste pick up is November 27. Please put your yard waste in yard waste bags or a container with a yard waste sticker on it for the garbage company to pick up. Last chipper pickup is the week of October 2.

Traveling out of the Country If you need a passport the Worth Village Hall can process your application for a passport book or passport card. Please bring proof of U.S. citizenship (original birth certificate or original naturalization paper), proof of id (valid driver's license or state ID), 1 passport picture (we do not take pictures), and check or money order for each application. Average processing time is about 4-6 weeks.

Hunting & Fishing License- The Village of Worth sells hunting & fishing licenses. Please bring your prior license or current driver's license and social security number.

Dog Owners When walking your dogs, please clean up after them. It is unlawful for animals to roam or be walked unleashed. Please set a good example and clean up after you pooches!

Drop Box For your convenience, a drop box is located at the main entrance of parking lot for payment of water bills, police tickets or other Village business where payment can be made by check. Payments may be deposited in the drop box 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The drop box is emptied every business day. No cash in the drop box.
