**VILLAGE PRESIDENT**

President Werner stated that the owners of 7103 W. 111<sup>th</sup> Street have accepted the offer we made to purchase the surrounding property at 7103 W. 111<sup>th</sup> Street for \$2.50 per square feet. The buyers will need to submit a plat of vacation to proceed with the purchase.

**VILLAGE CLERK**
