**Fence Requirements:**

- All supporting posts facing neighbor's property will be covered by fencing material facing outside or the fence must be installed between posts equal distance from each other facing side
- The maximum height of a privacy fence is 6ft and minimum of 2ft. The maximum height on a cyclone fence is 5ft. Cyclone fences higher than five feet (5') in height will be allowed in nonresidential areas, and only by variance granted by the real estate development board in accordance with the usual variance criteria and procedures. (Ord. 94-32, 10-4-1994).
- Cyclone fence webbing or slats are not allowed in residential areas except on residential lots abutting nonresidential lots. Webbing or slats are allowed in non-residential areas, but only by variance granted by the real estate development board in accordance with the usual variance criteria and procedures. No variance is required for cyclone fence webbing or slats on residential lots abutting nonresidential lots. (Ord. 96-13, 5-21-1996)
- Fence posts must be installed to a minimum depth below ground level of three feet (3'). All fence posts must be installed in the ground using concrete as a solid base support. (Ord. 94-32, 10-4-1994) All materials used must be the same texture, type, style and design; they must be harmonious material and approved by the building department.
- No fence shall be built, constructed or erected so as to extend past the front yard building line as established by the zoning ordinance, nor shall any fence be built past the side street yard on a corner lot as established by the zoning ordinance
